MDTP offers free diagnostic testing that provides teachers with insight into student thinking around key math concepts needed to be successful in middle and high school math courses.

MDTP has been providing this free service since 1986 with paper tests but is now moving to online testing.

Teachers who want to learn how to set up and use the MDTP online platform are invited to attend this workshop. We especially welcome teachers who are willing to share the process with their math department colleagues.

Attendees will learn how to:

- Set up MDTP online testing for their students.
- Incorporate the analysis of MDTP student test results to inform instructional practices. (5-step framework focusing MDTP formatively)
- Target instruction to address conceptual understanding.

A 90-minute hands-on workshop in the College of Natural Science and Mathematics computer lab will precede a convivial dinner at the Marriott at CSUF with other workshop attendees. The computer lab can only accommodate 36 participants, so registration is limited.

If you are confirmed to attend the workshop, proof of vaccination and masks will be required.
